Prevent Water Damage in Your Home

- Know where your home's main shutoff valve is located
- Have your air conditioning unit serviced regularly
- Investigate a sudden increase in your utility bill—this may indicate a leak
- Clear gutters and roof of debris regularly
- Check plumbing and water supply lines regularly for corrosion and condensation



If you experience a loss

1. Shut off water supply valve
2. Locate the source of the leak. Common culprits are faucets, toilets, water heaters, and refrigerator ice makers.
3. Turn off electricity in the affected area
4. Dry what you can; use fans to circulate the air
5. Report your claim 24/7/365 by contacting your carrier at the number provided on your declaration page
